## Report on the Use of the Promotion of Reading Grant <u>2019-2020</u> School Year

## Part 1: Evaluation of the Effectiveness

1. Evaluation of the objective: (Promote reading interest among students in learning and leisure reading)

The objective was partly achieved as many planned activities had been cancelled due to social movement and suspension of classes during the spread of COVID-19. Encountered with unexpected changes, recommended booklists were compiled and online reading activities were sent to students' emails. Without direct contact, the effectiveness was undermined. The figure in stakeholder survey concerning reading recorded a remarkable drop from 3.8 to 3.1. However, on the other hand, the usage of online reading platform, both HyRead and Highlights, marked a tremendous increase during the class suspension period. Also, there was a slight increase in the satisfactory rate of subject-based reading programme even though half of the topics were cancelled. The satisfactory rate rose from 65% (19-20) to 68% this year. It showed that reading interest among some students had been fostered.

**2. Evaluation of strategies:** In view of the changes occurred in 19-20, the importance of using electronic tools in reading became more obvious. Besides, students' network might be a valuable resource in promoting reading. Also, awards and gifts might sound effective among reluctant students.
